Southern Dirt Riders Association (SDRA) Rules

- 1. All trail riders must be members of SDRA with the exception of one or two day pass riders.
- 2. All riders MUST sign the Waiver-Release Form.
- 3. Safety gear minimum requirements Helmet, Boots, Gloves, and Goggles
- 4. All bikes must be able to pass a sound check and must not exceed 98 decibels. Don't be the one responsible for getting our property shut down!!!
- 5. No washing bikes on property.
- 6. No trail cutting or other property alterations are allowed without written permission from the club official.
- 7. Campfires are to be in designated areas, not in big field where we park. Please be responsible!!
- 8. No guests are allowed. Any member who brings a nonmember will be <u>subject to losing membership</u> <u>without refund</u>.
- 9. <u>Do not show up</u> on site and just think it's okay to ride because no one is there to sell you a pass. If you are riding without a pass or membership, you are trespassing and we are going to start fining for this offense. It is simply not fair that everyone pays except a few cheap-scapes!
- 10. All members should have SDRA sticker on their bikes. If member loses their sticker, do not ride but contact a club official immediately.
- 11. THERE SHALL BE NO ALCOHOL or other MIND ALTERING substances tolerated. This means trail rides, events, campouts, races, etc. Members will be subject to losing membership without refund.
- 12. Fighting; arguing; loud, vulgar, foul language will NOT be tolerated. This is to be a decent and family friendly atmosphere at all times.
- 13. No littering. You bring it in...You take it out.
- 14. There are signs in the main parking area indicating the direction you are to ride on any given day. Do NOT ride the wrong direction. Also, don't ride off of designated trails.

I WOULD READ THESE RULES!! In the last year, I have observed most all of these are broken or disregarded by some. If you are going to be dishonest enough to break the rules you signed your name to agreeing to keep; then the only choice I have is to revoke your membership.

Myself and a few others have put a lot into this property to offer a great place for everyone to ride. I believe that all the rules, formalities, and fees are necessary to be able to maintain and keep this property. Please do your part to help this be a great club and a great place to ride.
